Psychoanalysts apologize for harmful labels

In recognition of Pride Month, the American Psychoanalytic Association (APsaA) issued an "overdue apology" on Friday, June 21, for past views that pathologized diverse sexual orientations and gender identities as mental illness. The APsaA stated that these views contributed to discrimination and harmful conversion therapy, and acknowledged that "we all know hearing the words 'we are sorry' is important to healing past trauma."

Check out this major new survey on LGBTQ youth mental health

The Trevor Project recently released its *National Survey on LGBTQ Youth Mental Health (2019)* report, the largest survey ever conducted on mental health among American LGBTQ youth. Findings include:

- 39% of all LGBTQ youth, and more than half of transgender and non-binary youth, seriously considered suicide in the past year
- 42% of LGBTQ youth who underwent conversion therapy attempted suicide in the past year, including 57% of transgender and non-binary youth
- LGBTQ youth are disclosing their sexual orientation and gender identity to friends and some to adults. They are finding acceptance from friends, but at lower rates for gender identity than sexual orientation
